# Roanoke River Light

## North Carolina



May 23, 2007 was an important day for this once handsome River Light, one of dozens of screw-pile lights that guided mariners through the Pamlico, Albermarle, and Croatan Sounds. This once private residence was moved! The Roanoke river Light is the last surviving square screw-pile light in the world.

The United States Coast Guard, in 1973, had given title to the town of Edenton, NC the bell and Fourth Order Fresnel Lens. On May 15, 2007 the Roanoke River Light became the property of the Edenton Historical Commission, now in its new home, where it will be restored and open to visitors!
